



# CAMP RULES



1. The Scout Oath and Law are the standards for personal behavior in camp.
2. Fireworks, firearms, alcohol, illegal drugs, and drug paraphernalia are not permitted in camp.
3. Only your unit's trailer and vehicle towing it are permitted to drive on the grass and stay at your campsite. All other vehicles must be parked in a parking lot.
4. Tobacco products (including vapes) may only be used behind the dining hall fence by adults at least 21 years of age.
5. Pets are not allowed in camp.
6. Gambling is prohibited.
7. All Boy Scouts of America guidelines for co-ed camping must be followed.
8. All youth (anyone under the age of 18) must use the buddy system in camp.
9. All injuries must be reported to the camp immediately.
10. If inclement weather approaches, Scouts and leaders must follow the camp's safety instructions from the campmaster or ranger.
11. All fishing is catch and release.
12. You or your unit will be charged for any missing or damaged camp property.
13. Closed toed shoes must be worn, except for in the shower rooms.
14. All adults must be registered in the BSA for troop camping overnight.
15. Tree cutting or any other alteration to the appearance of camp is prohibited, unless given permission by the Ranger.
16. All rented facilities, must be cleaned before leaving.
17. Do not enter any facilities that are not rented by you or your unit.
18. All fires must be in a designated fire ring and kept to a reasonable size. A fire bucket must be kept near the fire and the fire must be supervised until it is completely out.
19. Do not bring firewood from home, only wood from Camp Oh-Da-Ko-Ta is permitted.
20. Gas/propane stoves and lighting are prohibited inside the adirondak shelters at Pioneer Village.
21. Checkout is at 11 am on Sunday, unless otherwise specified. All units must check out with the Ranger or Campmaster.

*Failure to comply with any of the above may result in you and your unit being asked to leave camp property and forfeit all fees paid.*
